Introduction

The Heat Transfer Society (*hts*) is the UK's leading society for those involved in heat transfer industries. In order to encourage university students to become involved in this increasingly important industry, *hts* has decided to make an annual Award for

**the best heat transfer project report with potential benefits for industry,
from a UK university undergraduate in the current academic year.**

Rules and Conditions

1. The award is limited to undergraduates in UK universities.
2. *hts* will make an annual award to the student considered to have made the most noteworthy contribution in the above field, except when it is considered that there are no nominations of a sufficiently high standard.
3. The winner of the award will be presented with
 - A certificate
 - A cash award
 - Life membership of the society
 - Invitation to *hts* Annual Dinner
4. The winner will be expected to make a presentation on their report at a meeting of *hts* members.
5. Nominations are to be submitted by the academic staff member who supervised the project, with the permission of the nominee.
6. Nominations may be submitted for a joint student project but the team will share the cash award.
7. Each nomination should include the following
 - Name of student(s)
 - Name of supervisor and institution
 - Brief description of project, highlighting its aims and benefits to industry. (Description shall not exceed 1000 words and not exceed 3 illustrations).
8. All nominations received by the due date will be considered by an Adjudication Panel set up by *hts*. The Adjudication Panel may call for additional information prior to making its decision.
9. The decision of the Adjudication Panel on any matter will be final.
10. *hts* will publicise the winning project and its author(s). *hts* will have the right to publish any information submitted, with appropriate acknowledgement.
